Illinois premium up 13.9% H1 2026 vs H1 2025

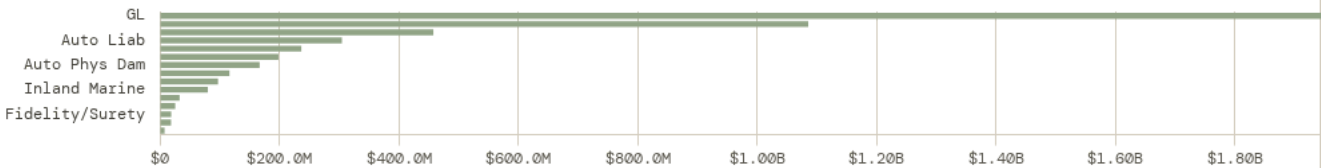
H1 2026 premium came in at \$2.58B — up \$314M from \$2.27B in H1 2025. From the [WSIA Midyear Report](#).
